Exelon Generation/ LU 614 begin early contract negotiations

In an effort to reach an early agreement, contract negotiations between Exelon Generation and IBEW Local 614 started during the week of November 5. IBEW Local 614 represents approximately 240 employees at Exelon Power. The current contract expires January 31, 2008.

Under the current contract, negotiations must begin “not less than 40 days prior to the end of the current term.” However, the Company invited the Union’s representatives to engage in negotiations, which began last week, in an attempt to reach an early agreement. The Union accepted the Company’s invitation with the understanding that it would lead to the achievement of the best agreement for its members.

“We are looking forward to a fruitful discussion with IBEW Local 614 and we are committed to negotiating an agreement that is fair to all parties,” said Mark Schiavoni, Exelon Power President.
